<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare the school site and undertake a thorough health and safety check prior to the return of the children. • Plan to put in place protective measures to reduce risks in agreement with the trust. • Have regular, stringent cleaning procedures in place. • Organise the staff and children into 'bubbles' to reduce the possibility of contact between different groups of children and adults. • Provide a range of educational opportunities for all children, both in school and at home where required. • Ensure that there is a designated safeguarding lead on the school site at all times to support children, staff and parents. • Cater for lunches of children in receipt of FSM or Universal FSM and those who pay for meals via ParentPay. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Agree that if their child, or anyone in their household shows symptoms of Covid-19, they will not enter the school site and will telephone the school to inform us. • Engage with the government led 'track and trace' system fully if the need should arise. • Prepare their child for the return to school including discussing the social distancing rules and changes to their routine that may be in place such as eating in classrooms. • Adhere to any altered routines for arrival or departure. • We will be operating a 'drop and go' system – parents will not be permitted to stay or gather on the school site. • Support the school in the behaviour policy put in place, understanding that your child's place will be reviewed if rules are broken and you may be asked to collect your child immediately. • Agree to collect your child and any of their siblings immediately should they be showing signs or symptoms of illness. • Understand that parents cannot come into the school building and any contact with school staff unless by prior arrangement via email or phone call. • Ensure that children are wearing their full school uniform each day, unless it is a PE day for their class and with shoes they can fasten themselves. • Support their child in learning from home should it be necessary due to isolation or a localised lockdown. • Provide your child with their own individual water bottle on a daily basis – rinsed and refilled. • Understand that some children may struggle to settle but staff will be unable to offer the usual level of support in terms of bringing the children into the building. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow any altered routines for arrival or departure. • Follow school instructions on hygiene, such as hand washing and sanitising. • Stay in their assigned 'bubble' in the allocated areas both in the classrooms and outside on the playground. • Follow all rules in the behaviour policy set out to support the safety of themselves and others, including the Behaviour policy addendum relating to Covid-19. • Engage with all learning set for them, whether at home or in school.
